


Safeguarding Adult Reviews

What is a Safeguarding Adult Review?



A Safeguarding Adult Review is when people look at how well everyone worked together to keep someone safe.

Why do we do Safeguarding Adult Reviews?



Because the Law tells us we have to.



So we can learn, make changes and do things better in the future.

Who will do the Review?



People who were not involved but who know what good is will do the review.



They may be people from the Council or the police or health.

How will we do the review?



We will have meetings.



We will ask people to write reports.


We will ask someone who does not know the case to help us see what went wrong and what needs to change.
